

BANGKOK STOPOVER

DAY 1 – BANGKOK

Arrive at Bangkok airport and transfer to hotel. Evening cruise and dinner on the Manohra, a magnificent converted rice barge. Overnight in Bangkok.

DAY 2 – BANGKOK

Visit Wat Po Temple to hear the monks' morning chanting ritual and see the reclining Buddha statue. Continue on to the Grand Palace for a guided tour. Take a long tail boat ride towards the north of the city through the labyrinth of "khlongs" (canals). Return by boat to Bangkok. Overnight in Bangkok.

DAY 3 – BANGKOK

After breakfast transfer to airport.

DAY 1 – LUANG PRABANG

Arrive at Luang Prabang airport, meet and greet, transfer to hotel. Overnight in Luang Prabang. (D)

DAY 2 – LUANG PRABANG

Travel aboard the elegant Nava Mekong boat up to the Pak Ou caves. Have lunch aboard. Return to Luang Prabang. Free time to explore the city. Overnight in Luang Prabang. (B,L)

DAY 3 – LUANG PRABANG - VIENTIANE

Explore Ban Xang Khok, where the local villagers specialize in the weaving of silk and cotton and the making natural paper products. Transfer to airport and fly to Vientiane. City tour including Wat Sisaket and Laos' own 'Arc de Triomphe'. Overnight in Vientiane. (B)

DAY 4 – VIENTIANE - HANOI

Visit the Buddha Park near the Thai border then continue to COPE, a center working to rid the country of landmines. This afternoon transfer to airport to fly to Hanoi (Vietnam). Overnight in Hanoi (B)

DAY 5 - HANOI

Full day guided tour of the city including Ho Chi Minh's mausoleum and former home, the ancient Temple of Literature and the Museum of Ethnology. Overnight in Hanoi (B)

DAY 6 – HANOI - HOI AN

Transfer to the airport and fly to Danang; drive to Hoi An. Take a tour of the ancient town centre to visit the homes of former merchants, the 400 year-old Japanese Covered Bridge and the exotic local market. Overnight in Hoi An. (B)

DAY 7 – HOI AN - HUE

Spend the morning in Hoi An, drive along the coast to Hue passing the Marble Mountains, Lang Co beach and the Pass of Ocean Clouds en route. Overnight in Hue. (B)

DAY 8 - HUE

Take a boat trip on Perfume River to visit the Thien Mu Pagoda. Drive through the countryside to visit the mausoleums of former Emperors. Free time in Hue to visit the market. Overnight in Hue. (B)

DAY 3 – YANGON – BAGAN

Transfer to airport, fly to Bagan. Transfer to hotel in Bagan. City tour of Bagan including the Shwezigon Pagoda, the Gubiyaukhyi Temple, Ananda Pahto and a lacquerware workshop. Overnight in Bagan. (B)

DAY 4 – BAGAN – MANDALAY

Transfer to the airport and fly to Mandalay. Transfer to hotel. City tour of Mandalay including the Golden Teak Monastery, Mahamuni Pagoda, Kyaukwangyi Pagoda, Sandamani Pagoda, and Kuthodaw Paya. Visit a craft workshop and observe the process of gold-leaf beating. Overnight in Mandalay. (B, L)

DAY 5 – MANDALAY – HEHO – PINDAYA

Transfer to the airport and fly to Heho. Transfer by private vehicle to Pindaya and visit the Pindaya Caves. Enjoy the beauty of the Shwe U Min Paya, a cluster of low stupas near the caves. Overnight in Pindaya. (B)

DAY 6 – PINDAYA – INLE LAKE

Transfer to Inle Lake and embark on a cruise of the Lake. Stop and visit the floating gardens, a traditional Intha village, the Phaung Daw Oo Pagoda, Inn Paw Khon village, and the Nga Phe Kyaung Monastery. Overnight at Inle Lake. (B)

DAY 7 – INLE LAKE – HEHO – YANGON

Spend another day on the lake, cruising to the western shore of to see the Indein Temple complex. Continue on foot to the village of Sae Ma. Afternoon transfer to airport and fly to Yangon. Transfer to hotel. Overnight in Yangon. (B)

DAY 8 – DEPART

Transfer to airport for final departure. (B)

Join the 'Road to Mandalay' for seven nights. Visit Mandalay, the centre of Burmese culture, and Sagaing famous for its silversmiths before cruising south to Bagan. Explore the magnificent temples and pagodas of Bagan and visit Mount Popa. Cruise north again to Shwe Kyet Yet and discover Shanlay village, considered to be the living centre of the Buddhist faith in Burma, and the beautiful hill station of Maymyo.

Day 1: Mandalay, Ava and Amarapura

Tour central Mandalay visiting the Mahamuni Pagoda and Shwe-im-bin teak carved monastery. Explore the ancient capitals of Ava and Amarapura, visiting the teak Bagaya Kyaung, Menu Ok-kyauing and crossing the U Bein Bridge.

Day 2: Yandabo Potteries Village

Yandabo is a very small rural village that specialises in pot making.

Day 3: Bagan Monuments

Tour a selection of the 3,000 listed monuments in this important World Heritage Site and visit lacquer workshops.

Day 4: Tan Kyi Taung Mountain and Salé

Ascend Tan-chi-taung mountain by foot or by WWII jeep for the spectacular sunrise over Bagan. In Sale visit a number of teak monasteries including the Yout-saun-kyauing with its spectacular wood carvings.

Day 5: Taung Ba Lu School and Magwe Gold Bricks

Morning visit to Taung Ba Lu School project Pandaw Cruises. Afternoon, we climb the river bank and wend our way through a labyrinth of passages and paths to reach the magnificent Myat-thalon Pagoda.

Day 6: Minhla Forts

Visit Minhla and Gwechaung, two Italian built forts constructed to keep the British at bay from Royal Myanmar. We climb the Gwechaung hill for the view.

Day 7: Thayetmyo Frontier Post

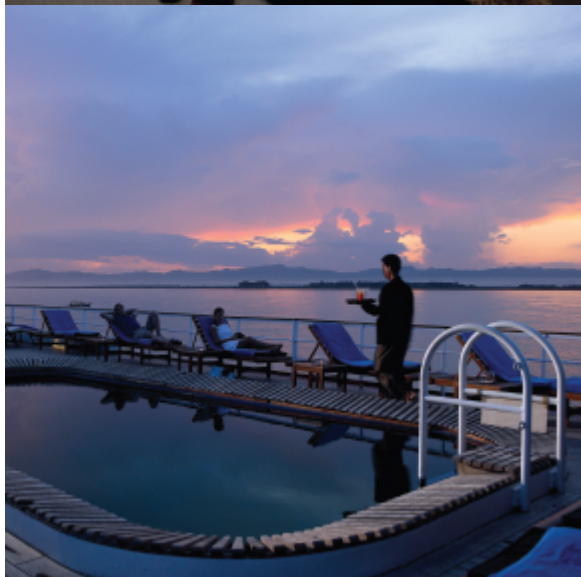
This pleasant colonial town once guarded the border between Royal Myanmar and British Myanmar following the 2nd Anglo Myanmar War of 1855 and many of the buildings including the covered market date from this period. Visit the market, see the colonial houses and ride out by horse and cart to see the countryside and golf links.

Day 8: Prome and the Ancient Pyu

Visit the 5th-8th century archaeological site of Thiri-ya-kittiya, former centre of the Pyu civilization with a fascinating museum of early Buddhist artifacts and sculpture.

Day 9: Prome / Yangon

Disembark at Prome and transfer to Yangon for drop at your designated hotel.



DAY 1 – YANGON - MANDALAY

Arrive at Mandalay airport, meet and greet, transfer to the 'Road To Mandalay' ship berthed on the Ayeyarwady River. Guided tour of Mandalay. Return to the ship. Dinner and local entertainment on board. (B, D)

DAY 2 - BURMESE VILLAGE

Visit a local village for a walking tour. Return to the ship; rest of the day spent aboard. An on-board guide lectures on the Myanmar way of life. Dinner and overnight on board. (B, D)

DAY 3 - BAGAN

Arrive at Bagan for a guided tour of the most important temples and pagodas. Dinner and local entertainment in the evening on board the ship. Overnight on board. (B, D)

DAY 4 – MOUNT POPA

Full day excursion to Mount Popa national park. Visit the complex of monasteries, pagodas and shrines. Return to the ship for dinner and local entertainment. Overnight on board. (B, D)

DAY 5 - BAGAN

Explore Bagan's local markets and see lacquerware being made. Board ship and sail to Mandalay. On board the guide lectures on the Ayeyarwady River. Cocktail party and dinner. Overnight on board. (B, D)

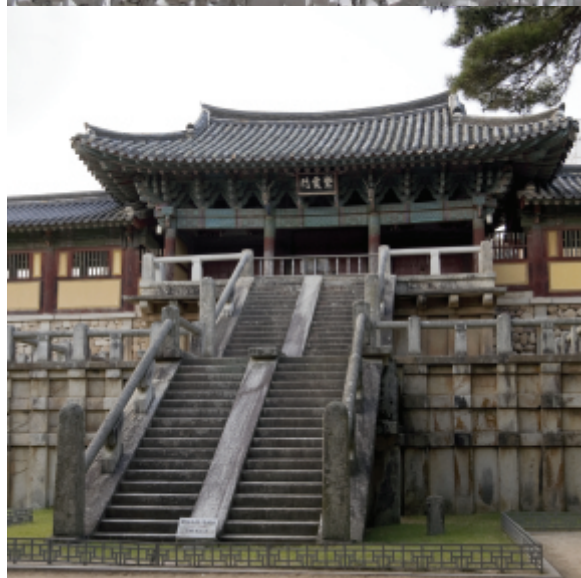
