Continue on to Lake Naivasha for a boat ride and then on to Amboseli. Mount Kilimanjaro broods high over the city. Overnight in Amboseli

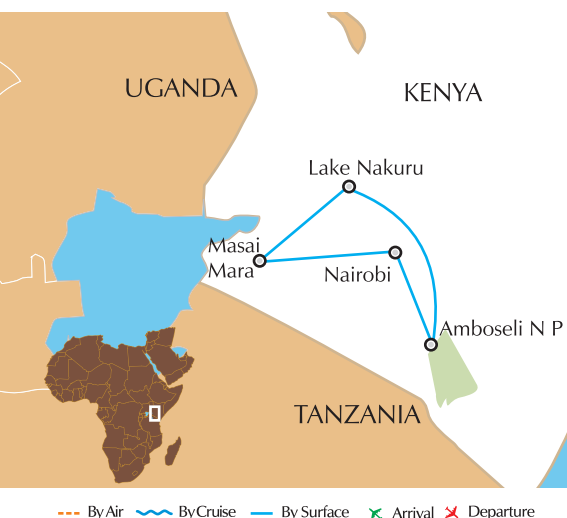
DAY 6: AMBOSELI NATIONAL PARK

Following an early breakfast this morning, catch your last views of majestic Mount Kilimanjaro as you depart Amboseli for Nairobi's International Airport for your onward flight.

From the open plains of The Masai Mara, the shimmering pink waters of Lake Nakuru and the swamps of Amboseli, this safari takes in three of the most picturesque regions in Kenya. It also provides the perfect opportunity to spot the Big-5 and to capture diverse scenery.

SAMBURU FLY-IN SAFARI

Enjoy Morning and afternoon shared game drives in Samburu National Reserve; home of many uncommon species such as reticulated giraffe, Grevy's zebra, Beisa oryx and the long-necked gerenuk antelope to name just a few. There are also many lions, cheetahs and leopards to spot as well as huge crocodiles in the rivers. Overnight at the Camp

DAY 3: SAMBURU/SHABA - NAIROBI

After breakfast, there will be a shared game drive transfer back to the airstrip for flight to Nairobi. Upon arrival, you will be met and transferred to a city centre hotel.

Did you Know?

The Maasai are a Nilotic ethnic group of semi-nomadic people inhabiting southern Kenya and northern Tanzania. Their traditional semi-nomadic lifestyle and their age-old customs have proven to be the best response to climate change because of their ability to farm in deserts and scrublands. Traditionally, the Maasai rely on meat, milk and blood from cattle for protein and caloric needs. Blood is very rich in protein and is good for the immune system.

Leave for a tour of the crater floor. Quite possibly the most famous of all Africa's conservation areas, this is one of the places in Africa where you stand a very good chance of seeing the Big 5. Later you will return to the lodge for an evening at leisure. Overnight in Ngorongoro

Early morning game drive before departing for Arusha. Later transfer to the airport for your onward journey.

Did you Know?

Lions don't sleep in the jungle at all. The word 'jungle' means dense, tropical rainforest. Almost all lions live on the savannah of sub-Saharan Africa.

Outside the mating season, they spend 20 hours a day lying down and snoozing, two hours walking and just under an hour eating. However, what hunting they do generally takes place at night. Lions can run at 50mph for short distances. During the mating season, lionesses have sex up to 50 times a day for four days and nights in a row with as many as five males – but each bout lasts only ten seconds.

DAY 1: NAIROBI

DAY 4: MASAI MARA - LAKE NAKURU

Depart the Masai Mara and head north to Narok, the district headquarters of this part of Maasailand. Lake Nakuru was originally declared a national park because of a superbly diverse bird population, which includes many migrants; the park is also a favourite place for travellers to seek the rare black rhino. However, it is for the flamingos that the lake is best known. Afternoon game drive in Nakuru National Park. Overnight at Lake Nakuru

DAY 5: LAKE NAKURU - AMBOSELI N P

Continue on to Lake Naivasha for a boat ride. Afterwards leave the Rift Valley behind and continue on to Nairobi for an early lunch or a picnic lunch en-route. Afternoon arrival in Amboseli, Mount Kilimanjaro broods high over the city. Overnight at Amboseli

DAY 6: AMBOSELI NATIONAL PARK

Spend the day at Amboseli National Park with early morning and afternoon game drives. Overnight in Amboseli

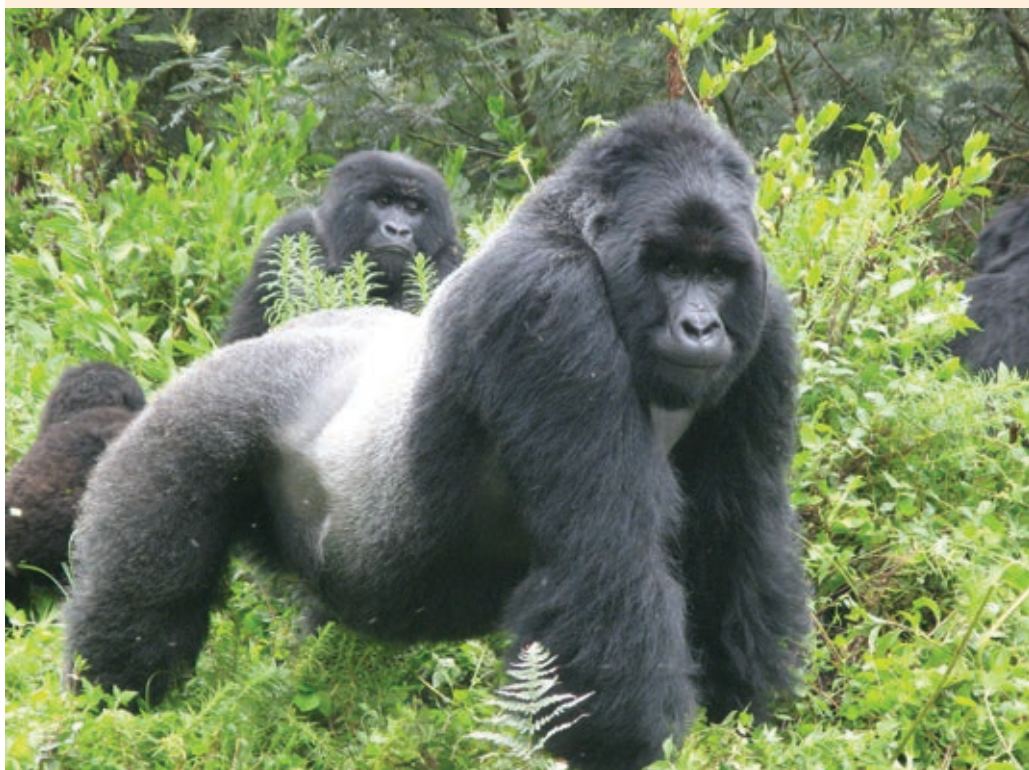

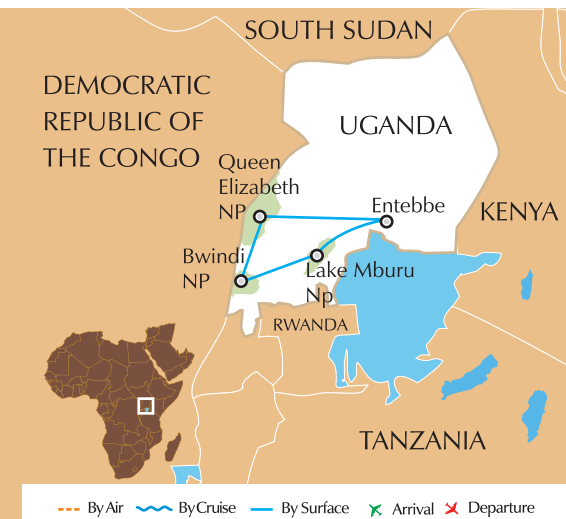

Gorillas are the largest living primates by physical size. The DNA of gorillas is highly similar to that of humans, from 95-99% depending on what is counted, and they are the next closest living relatives to humans after the chimpanzees and bonobos. Gorillas' natural habitats cover tropical or subtropical forests in Africa on a wide range of elevations. The mountain gorilla inhabits the Albertine Rift montane cloud forests of the Virunga Volcanoes. Lowland gorillas live in dense forests and lowland swamps and marshes as low as sea level.

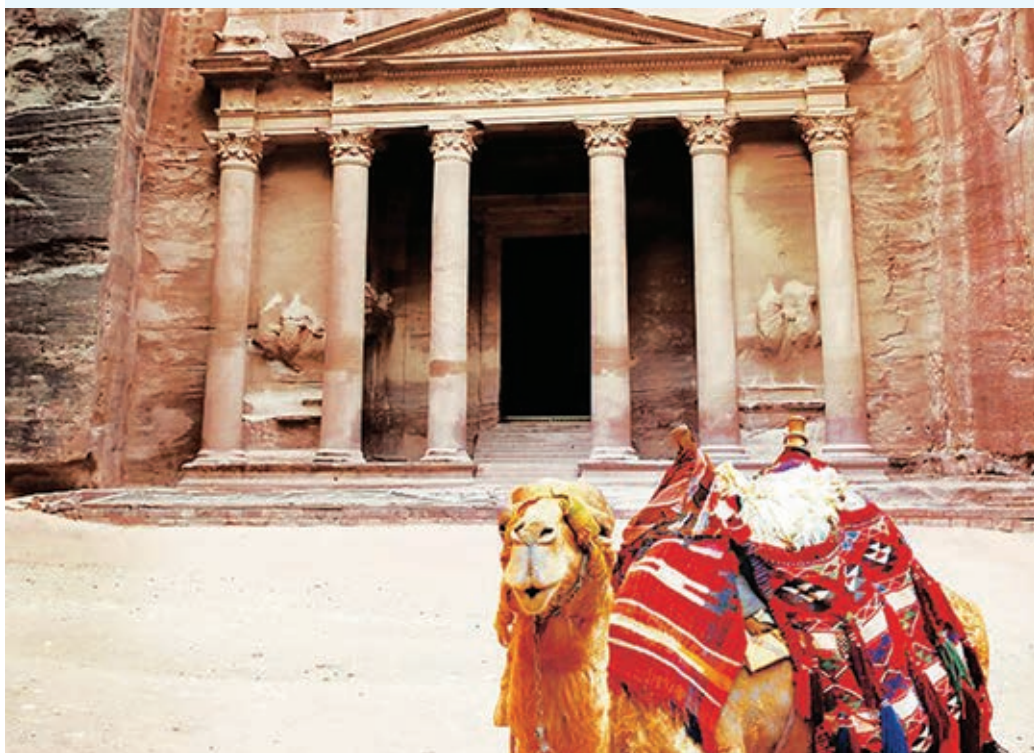

Did you Know?

The Palm Jumeirah is one of three Palm Islands to be created as an artificial archipelago in the Persian Gulf. It consists of a two kilometre-long tree trunk, a crown made up of 17 fronds and is surrounded by an 11-kilometre breakwater. It adds 78 kilometres to the Dubai coastline. It was constructed using over seven tons of rock and cost an estimated \$12 billion to build. Construction has started on the remaining two Palm Islands, Palm Jebel Ali and Palm Deira, but they have yet to be completed.

Finally, we visit the Grand Bazaar, where you can shop or haggle with local merchants over unusual antiques, colorful spices, beautiful jewelry and richly textured fabrics.
